

BOTTLED WATER MARKET GROWING

JOHANNESBURG – The South African bottled water market grew by more than 20% in the past two years, the SA National Bottled Water Association (Sanbwa) said on Monday.

Sanbwa chairman John Weaver said they believe changing lifestyle trends are responsible for the boom.

Over 260 million litres of bottled water were sold during 2006 at an average retail sales price of R7,19 per litre, a turnover of R2 billion. – Sapa.
